Tax back 2025: We thank our parishioners who participated in our Tax Back program during 2024 and we ask anyone who wishes to participate with us for 2025 to please do so. All that this requires is for a person to be paying tax and during the course of the year, if your contributions exceed €250.00, we can submit your name to revenue and the parish will receive €112 from the government, at no cost to yourself. In 1 parish, 70 people participated (€250.00/year,) and from their participation, in excess of €18,000 was received by the parish from the government, at no cost to the parishioners.
